Greetings,

On March 15 several of our high school students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. There are some misunderstandings as to the effects of this Sacrament such as that it makes us adults in the Church. This would be incorrect. On the flip side, one of the actual effects of Confirmation remains largely unknown and thus unused. Upon Confirmation, the recipient receives an increase of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit are "permanent dispositions that make us docile to follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit (CCC).

These gifts, however, must be practiced for them to grow within us. I have listed them below so that we can know what they are and how they are meant to work within us if we cooperate with God's grace.

Wisdom: The first and highest of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. It makes the soul responsive to God in the contemplation [deep thinking] of divine things. Where faith is the simple knowledge of the articles of Catholic belief, wisdom goes on to a certain divine penetration of the truths themselves.

Understanding: The gift of understanding enables us to know more clearly the mysteries of faith concerning faith and morals, Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition. It differs from faith because it gives insight into the meaning of what a person believes, whereas faith merely assents to [acknowledges] what God has revealed.

Counsel: (also known as Right Judgment) The gift of counsel helps us to discern what is right and what is wrong. It assists us in our ability to choose the path of God. The Holy Spirit speaks, as it were, to the heart and in an instant enlightens a person what to do.

Fortitude: Fortitude gives a special strength of will. This gift confers an extraordinary readiness to undergo trials for love of God or in fulfillment of God's will. Firmness in carrying out hard tasks. Perseverance in a lifetime of faithfulness to one's vocation in spite of heavy trials or disappointments. Gladness in being privileged to suffer persecution of humiliation in union with Christ and for the sake of His name.

Knowledge: This gift enables us to judge correctly about matters of faith and right action, so as to never wander from the straight path of justice. This gift helps to discern between the impulses of temptation and the inspirations of grace.

Piety: (also known as Reverence): The gift of piety helps us to love God, our merciful Father, and to obey his precepts out of love for him. It moves our heart from serving God out of duty and obligation into a relationship of love.

Fear of the Lord: (also known as Wonder and Awe) Commonly misunderstood as the fear of a wrathful God ready to smite us, the gift of fear of the Lord is actually more positive than negative. It consists of a recognition of the grandeur of God and his primacy over all things. Fear of the Lord recognizes that God is the creator and sustainer of the universe and we are his creatures. This gift helps us to understand how we must depend on God for everything. In other words, he is God, we are not.

As the All Things New team continues to work through the process, we thought we would provide an update on where we are in the process. The Bishop's decree is currently scheduled to be sent to all parishioners in the Diocese some time in April. The Disciples of The Mission All Things New transition team continues to meet and are waiting for further guidance and next steps from the Diocesan office. We are working through parishioner questions and responses are listed below.

Does my money go to my church? *The money will go to the corporation to which the parishioner belongs. The churches are within each corporation. Financial giving for each church will be monitored within the merged corporation.*

What happens to my church if financial support is reduced? *Financial support for each church will be monitored within the merged corporation. The Diocese along with the finance committees will continue to track and review parishioner support along with expenses for each corporation and the churches within that corporation. Should financial support be reduced to a point of no longer supporting the church, that church may close after a review of all the parameters, including the financial parameter.*

What will happen to the statues and "things" in the closed churches? Can they be moved somewhere that they can still be seen? *Fr. Theis will decide what will happen to the things in the church in cooperation with the finance council. This would include statues, images, etc. For personal donated items, the items will be reviewed and may be returned to the parishioner who donated them. Sacred vessels will remain for liturgical use only.*

Will families/individuals of St. Ann and Sacred Heart automatically be transferred to our Lady of Seven Dolors? *Both corporations will be merged into Our Lady of Seven Dolors. All sacramental records will be kept at Our Lady of Seven Dolors. If a parishioner desires to choose to join a different parish, it doesn't change their place of sacramental record. Parishioners who are members of the closing churches will need to contact Laura to confirm which parish they will be joining.*

When forming a new corporation, what happens with the Trustees? *There will be two Trustees for each corporation. Each church will have representation on the finance council.*

If we're giving in the collection, what will happen to the money? *We are still providing ministries and building expenses/maintenance/insurance needs to continue until the relegation plans are complete.*

Why is SE at 8 am and SW at 8:30 am? *The four Mass options on Sunday and two Mass options on Saturday within the ACC provide a variety of opportunities for parishioners to attend the Mass that best meets individual schedules.*

How will the choirs be used at OLSD? Pianists/SH Choir/OLSD choir? *The process has already begun to include several musicians who are interested in helping with music.*


