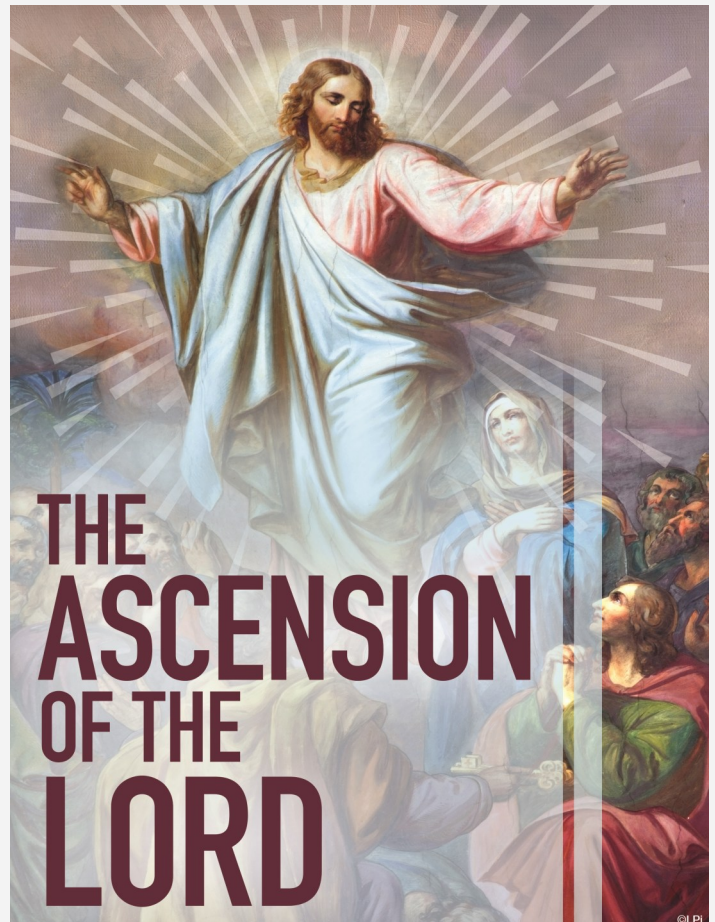
'The Lord ascended into Heaven and is now seated at the right hand of the Father', we believe and profess through the Creed. Christ's Ascension was the culmination of God's Divine plan for Christ Jesus – his return to his Father with his 'Mission Accomplished'. Being seated at the right hand of the Father is the fulfillment of the Prophet Daniel's vision concerning the Son of Man: 'He received dominion, splendor, and kingship; all nations, peoples and tongues will serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, his kingship, one that shall not be destroyed' (Daniel 7:14).

The Biblical accounts of the Ascension focus not so much on the details of the event as on the mission ('preach the Good News and be my witnesses') Jesus gave to his disciples. In the accounts recorded in the Gospel of St. Luke and Acts of the Apostles, the Ascension took place in Jerusalem and it happened forty days after the Resurrection, a period during which Jesus appeared repeatedly to his followers. In St. Matthew and St. Mark, on the other hand, the event occurred in Galilee and there is no indication of a time period between the Resurrection and the Ascension. All accounts, however, agree that the Ascension took place on a mountain.

As we celebrate the Lord's return to His Father in Heaven – His Ascension – we, too, are being commissioned to go forth and proclaim the Gospel of life and love, of hope and peace, by the witness of our lives. On this day of hope, encouragement, and commissioning, let us renew our commitment to be true disciples everywhere we go, living in a manner worthy of the call we have received.

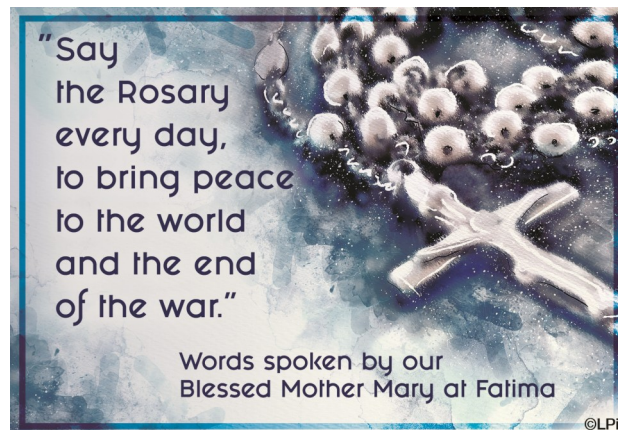

All Things New Updates

We anticipate the arrival of the Bishop's decree some time in May and continue to discuss events and ideas to honor generations and ancestors along with events and ideas to evangelize and build community and relationships.

The new Mass schedule will be completely implemented by July 1, 2026. Watch the bulletin for the Mass time schedules. Until we receive the final decision from the diocese and as per the Milestone Moment article from Brenda Kresky, churches where Masses are no longer held will still be used on an infrequent basis.

Here are a few more questions from parishioners. Some are summarized due to the same question from multiple parishioners.

How will you safeguard the historical, material, and human patrimony of parishes? Should the final decisions from the diocese result in the closing of Sacred Heart and St. Ann, Fr. Theis will decide what will happen to the things in the church in cooperation with the finance council. This would include statues, images, etc. For personal donated items, the items will be reviewed and may be returned to the parishioner who donated them. Sacred vessels will remain for liturgical use only.

Many want the top three reasons Sacred Heart and St. Ann were chosen to close. The team made recommendations using all the parameters provided by the Diocese. Those parameters were the guiding principles when recommending the closing of Sacred Heart and St. Ann. The same parameters were used by all Area Catholic Communities in the diocese when considering the recommended plans.

Why can't funds earned from special events be used to pay normal building operating expenses? Funds earned from special events are not consistent income. It would be like including a bonus as part of your regular income to pay expenses but when that bonus isn't available, regular expenses can't be paid.

How can one person make the decision to close churches when many, not all, think it is not right? One person is not making the decision to close churches. The ACC proposals are being reviewed by multiple groups including representatives from other ACC's, priests, diocesan staff, financial advisors, legal representation, and the Bishop.

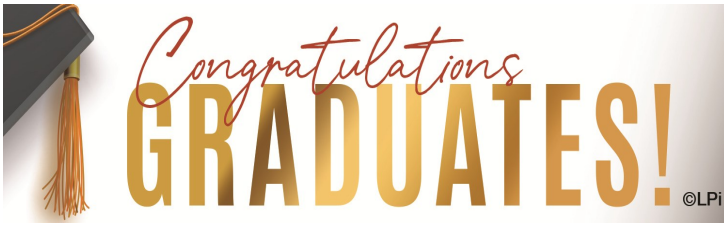

Volunteer opportunities coming this summer!

Our Area Catholic Community will be hosting Totus Tuus again this summer for children entering 1st grade- through 12th grade. This year’s program will be at the Church of St. Edward in Henning Minnesota. The program will run from Sunday July 19th-Thursday, July 23 for youth entering 7th grade- through 12th grade and from Monday July 20th-Friday July 24th for youth entering 1st grade- through 6th grade.

Our team of Totus Tuus missionaries, two men and two women will arrive in our ACC on Saturday July 18th and stay until Friday evening, July 24th.

We are looking for volunteers to house the teams, either the two women or the two men and provide breakfast each morning.

The team will arrive after dinner on Saturday and will leave either on the following Friday or Saturday morning. The teams usually are out the door by 7:30 a.m. and will not return until approximately 9:30 p.m. each day. Due to the Diocese rules on Safe Environment the teams cannot stay in any home where there are minor children present overnight. Also, because the team will only have one vehicle, they prefer to be housed within 10 miles- 10 minutes from the Church site.

We are also looking for families to provide meals for the Team during their stay.

Lunch each day, Sunday through Thursday. Sunday’s lunch can be at your home or at a restaurant.

Lunch, Monday through Thursday, at approximately 12:00 p.m. Lunches can be dropped off at the Church and should serve approximately 6-7 people, (the team and priests and volunteers). The team has lunch around 12:15 p.m. each day.

Dinners, Sunday through Wednesday, at approximately 5:15 p.m. Your family may bring food to the Church and join the team there, or have the team come to your home for dinner, or take them out to a restaurant.

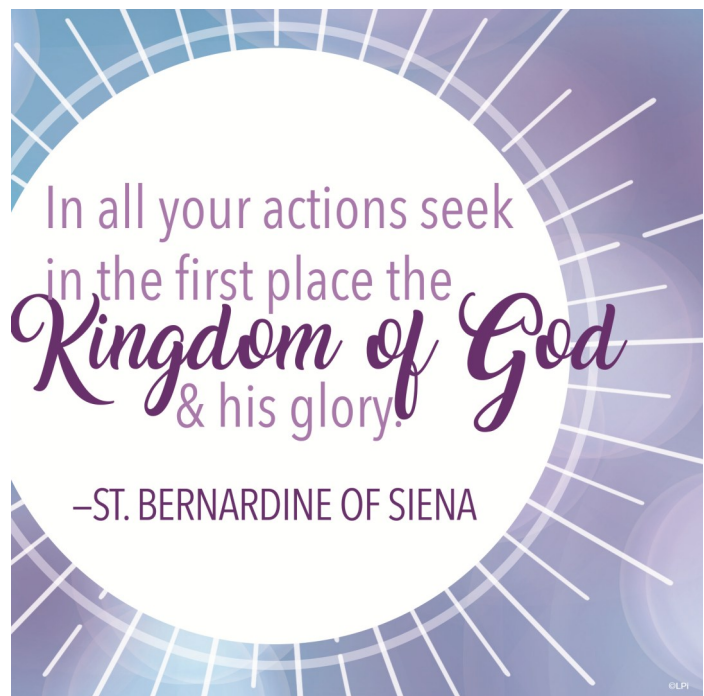
