Greetings,

“I belong to Paul,” or “I belong to Apollos,” or “I belong to Cephas,” or “I belong to Christ.” Is Christ divided? (1Cor 1:12) The first problem St. Paul addresses is that of divisions within the Corinthian community because several factions had arisen among them, each claiming allegiance to its first Christian teacher or to a particular Apostle such as Peter, Paul, or Apollos. When we identify with someone/something other than Christ as the foundation of our identity, we drive division into Christ’s body and become a threat to His community.

Unity is essential for fulfilling Christ's mission in the world. As St. Pope John Paul II emphasized, the unity of Christ’s disciples is a condition for effectively proclaiming and consolidating faith in Him – Jesus. When we stand united, we bear witness to the love of God revealed in Christ, and we fulfil the prayer of Jesus, who asked the Father that we all may be one, so that the world may believe. (Cf Jn 17)

Our unity can be a powerful witness. In our daily lives, the call to unity challenges us to seek reconciliation and understanding with our fellow members. It invites us to engage in dialogue, to listen, and to learn from one another. Each of us has a role to play in fostering this unity, whether through prayer or acts of kindness.

We can and do travel together as pilgrims in a Church which is compassionate, humbled and renewed. Our first duty is the worship of Almighty God. If we can be faithful to that; the Lord will lead us together as friends and pilgrims of hope to unexpected and new pastures.

Unity emphasizes Jesus' prayer for believers to be one (Jn 17), reflecting the Trinity, so the world believes in Him, finding that unity through love, the Eucharist, (a powerful act of becoming one with Jesus and each other, healing divisions and nourishing the spiritual life needed for unity) and the Holy Spirit, overcoming internal and external divisions by seeking common ground, avoiding gossip, and humbly serving others to become a powerful, visible sign of Christ's presence. Unity is a gift and also a mission that Jesus entrusts to us. It is through our unity that the world will recognize the truth of Christ's love and His divine mission. Let us be agents of unity by practicing love, seeking understanding, avoiding judgment, and praying for others.


St. Thomas Aquinas | Catholic Saints


