Jesus continues his teaching on the “Kingdom of Heaven” using parables based on the experiences of rural Galileans. Like Jesus’ parables of the mustard seed and the yeast, those of the treasure and the pearl form a pair of His “Kingdom parables.” Jesus tells us that true wisdom involves recognizing a pearl of great price and being willing to sacrifice all to purchase it.

A well-to-do merchant on the lookout for quality pearls finds a “pearl of great price” and he immediately “sells everything” to buy it. Jesus wants us to know that the Kingdom of God is worth all we have. He has come to offer us God’s Kingdom, a unique pearl of the greatest price. The genuine disciples are those who respond to this opportunity with joy and selfless commitment, eagerly giving top priority to life in the Kingdom by doing God’s will, whatever it may be. The “treasures” and “pearls” of lasting value are the love of family and friends, the support of community, and the sense of fulfillment that rises from serving and giving for the sake of others. In order to attain such treasure, we must “sell off” our own interests, ambitions, and agendas and thus free ourselves to embrace the lasting values of the compassion, love, and mercy of God, who reconciles us to Himself.

When one discovers Jesus and his vision of life, everything else becomes secondary. Saint Matthew, a tax-collector, might have experienced something like this when he discovered the eternal value of the Kingdom preached by Jesus of Nazareth. When he discovered Jesus and his vision of life, everything else became secondary. That is what St. Paul meant when he said: “I even consider everything as a loss because of the supreme good of knowing Christ Jesus, my Lord. For his sake I have accepted the loss of all things, and I consider them so much rubbish, that I may gain Christ” (Phil 3:8), and again “For to me, life is Christ, and death is gain” (Phil 1:21). To have a personal experience of Christ and personal relationship with Him – in other words, to have made Christ’s view of life one’s own – is the most precious thing in the world.

All Things New Updates

As we continue to work through the All Things New process, and anticipate the changes coming with the decrees for our ACC, here are some points of reflection excerpted from “Agents of change: Stepping forward in faith” by Jon Ruis, January 2025, The Central Minnesota Catholic



One of the hardest things for us to come to grips with is that change happens with or without us. For thousands of years, writers and philosophers have been trying to help us understand this aspect of our life. Plato wrote, “You could not step twice into the same river.” Ecclesiastes 3:1 states “There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens,” highlighting the cyclical and changing nature of life’s events.

We cannot stop the flow of the river or the changing of the seasons; our efforts can be better spent deciding how we can take advantage of this change.

As baptized Catholics, we are called to be more than passive participants in our faith; we are invited to be active agents of change, carrying forward the evangelizing mission of the Church. This is not an abstract ideal, but a living call rooted in the Gospel and brought to life in our parishes, families and communities. Being an agent of change means embracing this identity. It’s a role that asks us to step outside of comfort zones and engage deeply with the needs of our communities.

Here are some things you can do to engage and possibly step outside of your comfort zone.

- Show up with purpose. Don’t just attend Mass — prepare for it. Read the Scriptures ahead of time, pray for your parish community and ask God to show you who might need encouragement that day.
- Practice radical hospitality. Greet newcomers, sit with someone alone, invite a family to coffee and donuts. Small acts of welcome can change someone’s experience of Church.
- Serve in simple, concrete ways. Volunteer as a catechist, lector or choir member. Help clean the parish hall. Offer rides to those who can’t get to Mass. Missionary discipleship is lived in ordinary service.
- Share your faith story. Talk about how God has worked in your life. Share a moment of grace with a friend or fellow parishioner. Witness doesn’t require a microphone.
- Step into the margins. Visit the sick, bring meals to families in crisis, support local outreach ministries. Missionary disciples go where the need is greatest.
- Pray for renewal. Make intercession part of your daily rhythm. Pray for your parish, your pastor and those struggling with change. Prayer is the engine of mission.

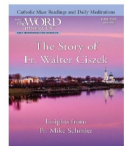

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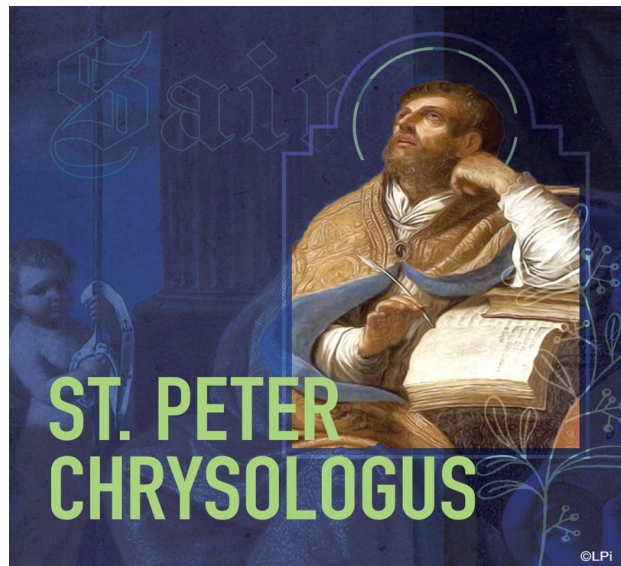
