If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother". (Matthew 18:15)
Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that (CCC #2475) "Christ's disciples have "put on the new man, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness." [Ephesians 4:24] By "putting away falsehood," they are to "put away all malice and all guile and insincerity and envy and all slander." ["Therefore, putting away falsehood, speak the truth, each one to his neighbor, for we are members one of another" Ephesians 4:25; "Rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, insincerity, envy, and all slander;" 1 Peter 2:1] This passage (CCC # 2475) establishes the foundation for Christian conduct in speech and action, highlighting the importance of honesty and uprightness in personal and social life.

CCC # 2477: "Respect for the reputation of persons forbids every attitude and word likely to cause them unjust injury. He becomes guilty: - of rash judgment who, even tacitly, assumes as true, without sufficient foundation, the moral fault of a neighbor; - of detraction who, without objectively valid reason, discloses another's faults and failings to persons who did not know them; ["Slanderers sully themselves, and are hated by their neighbors". Sirach 21:28] - of calumny who, by remarks contrary to the truth, harms the reputation of others and gives occasion for false judgments concerning them".

The faithful are called to avoid all forms of lying, including malicious speech, slander, and insincerity, which harm both personal integrity and the community.

CCC 2475 'is part of the section on Offenses Against Truth, which teaches that Christians must respect the dignity and reputation of others, avoid rash judgment, and interpret others' words and actions charitably. It underscores that truthfulness is essential for justice, charity, and the moral life, and that every believer is called to witness to the truth in daily life, both publicly and privately.

In practice, this means Christians should: Speak honestly and avoid deception. Refrain from spreading false information or gossip. Strive to understand others' intentions before judging. Promote justice and fairness in all interactions.

Thus this paragraph (CCC # 2475) serves as a moral and spiritual guide, reminding the faithful that truthfulness is central to Christian discipleship and the imitation of Christ'. (Cf. CCC #2479; # 1753)

INTRODUCING...



We are so excited to begin Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, a Montessori approach to the religious formation of children at Saint Edward's Church. OLSD Site:

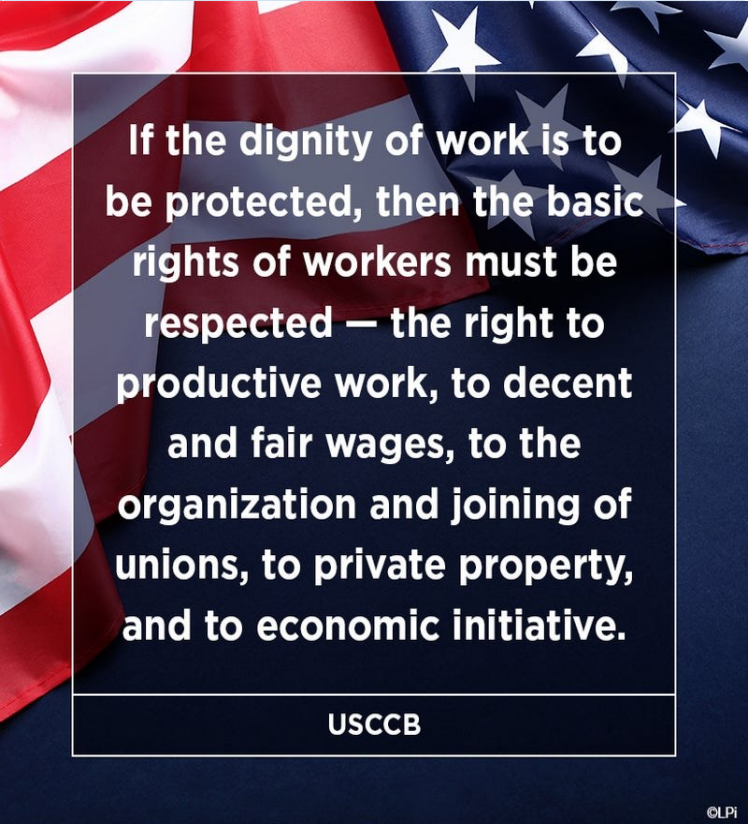
Faith Formation at the above sites will begin on Wednesday, September 9 for all students grades 1-10. Safe Environment at both sites.

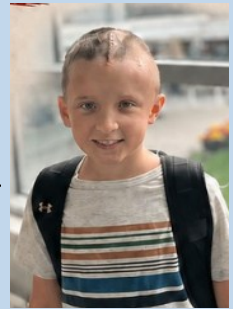
